Capt. Hutchins began his career as a seaman with Irving Oil in Canada and over the next 19 years progressed through the ranks ending his sea-going career as Master of the passenger ferry Pride of Bilbao with P&O European Ferries. His sea career took him from the High Arctic to the Tropics and before leaving the sea obtained his Pilot Exemption Certificate for the Port of Portsmouth UK.

After this period Capt. Hutchins began as lecturer at the Shipping and Transport College on nautical subjects, with focus on the radar simulator. Since beginning his lecturing career he has been heavily involved in development of the Advanced Fire-Fighting course and other courses such as Radar Observer, Radar Navigator, Bridge Team Management and Resource Management involving the radar simulator. In 2003 assumed the role of project leader for the Ship Security Officer and Company Security Officer courses. He has developed classroom and CBT courses for Ship Security Officer, Company Security Officer and Port Facility Security Officer. In 2003 became certified as a Work-Shop Leader for the Stockholm Flight Academy Bridge Resource Management (SAS-BRM) Course. The subject matter covered within the SAS-BRM includes but is not limited to: Workload, Stress, Crisis Management and Critical Incident debriefing. In 2004 assumed the role of Senior ISPS consultant for the Shipping and Transport College lecturing in Port Facility Officer courses and Audit Team courses in line with the ISPS Code requirements. In mid, 2004 assisted in the development of the Port Security Plans and Port Facility Security Plans within the Republic of South Africa. In the fall of 2004 executed an ISPS compliance status review of all the ports within the Republic of South Africa on behalf of the National ports Authority (NPA).
